

Fayette Local Schools Archery Program

The Archery Club students have the opportunity to meet regularly to practice, as well as attempt to qualify to be a member of the Fayette Eagles Archery Competition Team. As a participating school, students may also have the opportunity to compete in local area shoots with other districts, as well as the Ohio NASP State Tournament as a club member. Students may also have the opportunity to take extended trips to other shoots as part of our club.

As we move forward, Fayette Archery Club volunteers, remind students and parents that the Archery Club is for students to get involved in an activity, learn a life skill and enjoy a rewarding sport. Thus, situations may arise, may be unexpected or unique, and club instructors will try and address these situations as amicable as possible, as we want this to be an enjoyable experience for all participants.

Safety

Safety is the #1 concern for all participants involved with the Archery program. Therefore, any safety violation, as well as any disruptive behavior, will result in the participant being asked to sit out. If safety violations and/or behavioral issues continue, the participant will be asked to leave or will be dropped as a club member with no refund of the club fee. Students must also follow all school related rules and guidelines set forth in the student hand books. Home Instruction students must also follow the same rules and guidelines set forth in the student handbook. If a fee structure is applicable for such participation in activity, Home Instruction students are required to pay the same as current district students. If a copy of the student handbook is needed, please contact a school office.

Dress Code

- The school dress code as outlined in the student handbook will be followed for all archery practices and tournaments
 - *Please be aware that only **close-toed shoes** may be worn when shooting and archers will not be permitted to shoot at an organized shoot if they are wearing open-toed shoes*
- As a team we will wear our team shirts with pants (jeans, khakis, etc.) that meet the school dress code to all archery tournaments as a team “uniform”

Discipline

The following is a list of expectations for archery club members and spectators:

Practice

- Be committed to attending practice regularly
- Respect all Fayette Eagle Archery Club coaches and parents
- Obey all whistle commands
- Obey all range safety rules
- Remain quiet while others are on the line shooting
- Do not hit, push, shove, or otherwise intimidate another club member
- Be respectful of all schools facilities

Club members who do not follow the rules will be removed from practice. Club members who repeatedly fail to obey the rules will be removed from the archery club.

Tournaments

- Respect all Range Officials and coaches
- Obey all whistle commands
- Obey all range safety rules
- Remain quiet while others are on the line shooting

- We will sit together in the stands as a team
- Represent the Fayette Eagle Archery Club in a positive manner
- Dress appropriately in team shirt and pants

Club members who do not follow the rules will be removed from the tournament. Club members who repeatedly fail to obey the rules will be removed from the archery club.

Competition Team(s)

A competition team(s) may be formed to compete for Fayette Local Schools. The team will be co-ed and consist of at least 5 members of the opposite gender. (Ex.: 10 boys & 10 girls, 15 boys & 5 girls, 7 boys & 13 girls). If we have enough students participating, potentially the school could have several teams by grade bands; elementary (grades 4-5), middle school (Grades 6-8) or high school (Grades 9-12) with each potential team consisting of a maximum of 15 shooters.

Who is eligible?

- Any student who has participated in the 4th-12th grade physical education beginner archer instruction class.
- Or any student grades 4-12 who attends mandatory practice sessions that will consist of beginner instructions.

Additional eligibility requirements:

- ****All participating students must have all school fees paid, as well as club fee to attend any meet/shoot.**
- Participating students must attend all mandatory practice qualifying shoots prior to the tournament. Any participant that misses a mandatory shoot will not be allowed to make this shoot up. (See practice schedule)
- Participating students must be in good academic and behavioral standing. Students failing this requirement will not be eligible to participate at any shoot.
- Permission forms and other required documents must be on file with the Archery Club for any student to participate in traveling or extended meets.
- If you have any questions regarding this issue, please feel free to contact the school.

Costs:

- There is a \$20 fee per student to participate in the club for '15-'16 school year, payable to Fayette Local Schools. *PAYMENT DUE before first event.
- The student may need to pack a lunch or have funds for a lunch on the days of any tourney/or shoot and additional money may be needed for food following the event, unless otherwise noted.
- ****Additional costs may be required of student participants if attending the Ohio NASP State Tournament, the National Tournament or regional shoots with other local schools. These costs could include, but not limited to: Transportation, lodging, meals, student registration fees, etc.**
